Biometric information is collected for a lawful purpose

- Purpose is connected to a lawful activity of your organisation
- Purpose is specific and relevant at the time of collection

Biometric information is necessary to achieve your purpose

- Biometric processing is effective at achieving the lawful purpose
- There is no reasonable alternative way of achieving your lawful purpose as effectively that has less privacy risk



Appropriate privacy safeguards have been implemented

 You have implemented safeguards that are reasonable in the circumstances

Biometric processing is proportionate to the likely impacts

- You have assessed the privacy risk, benefit and cultural impacts on Māori from the biometric processing
- Overall, the benefit outweighs the risk and you have sufficiently addressed any cultural impacts
