**1. Title**

This amendment is the Justice Sector Unique Identifier Code 1998 Amendment No 4.

**2. Commencement**

This amendment will come into force on 15 October 2015.

**3. Amendment to clause 3 (Interpretation)**

Clause 3(2) is revoked.

*Note: Clause 3(2) dealt with statutory interpretation of terms and expressions used in the Code. This clause has been removed on the basis that general principles of statutory interpretation made the provision redundant.*

**4. Amendment to clause 5 (Rule modifying the application of information privacy principles 12)**

Clause 5(2)(a) is amended as follows:

Delete: section OD7 of the Income Tax Act 1994

Substitute: subpart YB of the Income Tax Act 2007

*Note: This amendment substitutes a replacement Act for repealed legislation.*
